Mr. Diaz began the meeting by reviewing ground rules.

SIP team agreed to ground rules.

Goal: Students Achievement:

Team agreed to cut benchmarks out of the SIP. Benchmarks will be replaced by the in house assessment (Curriculum Based Measurement, CBM).

This is happening because the benchmark has been restructured and is being implemented in its current format for the first time.

Also, we have started using the CBM regularly. It makes sense to review this data as a data point.

CBM frequency is still to be determined (Chaney needed). Tentatively it will occur during the beginning of the year, middle of the year and end of year. Middle of the year testing occurs because we usually bring in a new cohort of students mid year.

Rubrics will be presented to leadership team to begin garnering feedback.
